With over 30 years' experience in the field of forensics, he has represented the UK in overseas Disaster Victim Identification deployment, such as the response to the Boxing Day Tsunami in 2004. He has also served on secondment with the PSNI to assist in the investigation of the former

"troubles" in Northern Ireland. Paul was selected as the Western European (as it was then) delegate for the development of fingerprint examination techniques in Albania and is currently engaged in the development of fingerprint examination techniques to support the investigation of International wildlife crime in Zimbabwe. He has also been fortunate to chair and present at the APAC Police Technology conference in Malaysia pre-Pandemic in 2019.
